1. The Uppsala/Human Security Centre dataset's best estimate of battle-related deaths from state-based conflict in 2002 is 15,575 (as opposed to the 19,368 recorded by Lacina and Gleditsch). While the Lacina and Gleditsch dataset relies heavily on Uppsala's findings, the definition of 'battle-deaths' it employs is more inclusive than that of 'battle-related deaths'.
